





Getting to Trier

Arriving by plane

Luxembourg Airport (LUX)

Luxembourg-Findel Airport is about 30 minutes by car from Trier, a fact that your local travel agent may not be aware of, with direct flights from many cities in Europe.

\rightarrow Bus shuttle Luxembourg Airport - Trier

Public transport in Luxembourg is free of charge.

As free transport ends at the border, you will need a cross-border ticket, which costs EUR 5 to Trier. The journey takes between 1 hour 10 minutes and 1 hour 40 minutes.

Please find here the links to the relevant timetables:

- **Bus 302** from Luxembourg Airport to Trier, Christophstraße (only between 12:30 and 20:34) and 20 minutes walk or bus 5 from Nordallee to Wisportstraße and 5 minutes walk.
- Bus 6/16 from Luxembourg Airport to Kirchberg Luxexpo and 303 from Kirchberg Luxexpo to Trier, Gilbertstraße and 12 minutes walk.
- Bus 29 from Luxembourg Airport to Cents-Hamm and RB83 to Trier-Süd and 10 minutes walk.
- Bus 29 from Luxembourg Airport to Luxembourg Gare Centrale and RE1/RB83 to Trier-Süd and 10 minutes walk.

Hahn Airport (HHN)

Hahn Airport is about 50 minutes away by road.

The connection by public transport from Hahn Airport to Trier is not optimal. It is easiest to order a taxi, but this can be expensive. Sharing a taxi with other people could be a cheaper option.

Getting to Trier

Arriving by car

There are motorway connections from Luxembourg, Cologne, Koblenz and Saarbrücken.

From Koblenz/Saarbrücken/Kaiserslautern (A48 /A1), drive straight from the freeway to Moseluferstraße (do not exit Trier Nord, Stadtmitte), continue along the Mosel until you reach Römerbrücke (second bridge over the Moselle), immediately after Römerbrücke turn left into Südallee. Please follow the signposting "Centrum/Mariahof/ERA/ECC".

The road passes the Kaiserthermen on the left and leads into a roundabout which you should leave by turning right - direction Mariahof. At the first light that follows, turn right again and then left. You are in front of the ERA underground car park with 140 parking spaces.

From Köln/Bitburg (A64/B51) cross the Moselle towards the centre, then turn right into Moseluferstraße, continue along the Moselle until you reach Römerbrücke (second bridge over the Moselle). Immediately after Römerbrücke turn left into Südallee.

Please follow the signposting "Centrum/Mariahof/ERA/ECC". The road passes the Kaiserthermen on the left and leads into a roundabout which you should leave by turning right - direction Mariahof. At the first light that follows, turn right again and then left. You are in front of the ERA underground car park.

Overnight accommodation in Trier

There are special rates for ERA participants at three excellent hotels in Trier.

Vienna House Easy by Wyndham

Adjacent to ERA and directly accessible via a glass walkway, the 4-star Vienna House Easy by Wyndham Trier has over 105 comfortable rooms. It is about 1km from the city centre and the Porta Nigra (1.5km), Amphitheatre (0.5km) and Constantine's Basilica (1km) are within easy reach by foot.
